## Getting to the MCA

The MCA is located on Circular Quay West, Sydney, and is easily accessible by public transport. The Museum is a short walk from all major transport stops. To plan your trip on public transport, visit [transportnsw.info](http://transportnsw.info)

### Train

The closest train station is Circular Quay Station (a 2-minute walk to the MCA).

### Bus

You can catch the bus to Circular Quay or George Street (a 5-minute walk to the MCA).

### Ferry

Cruise over the harbour to the Circular Quay Terminal (a 3-minute walk to the MCA).

### Car

There is no onsite parking. For the closest parking stations to the MCA, see below.

## Important travel information

Transport for NSW is currently building a new light rail. Due to road closures along northern sections of George Street, roads surrounding the MCA will be exceptionally busy. Allow extra time when travelling by car, especially during peak times, and use the city's preferred driving routes.

**OVERSEAS PASSENGER TERMINAL** Lower Argyle Street, The Rocks (Subject to cruise ship movements)

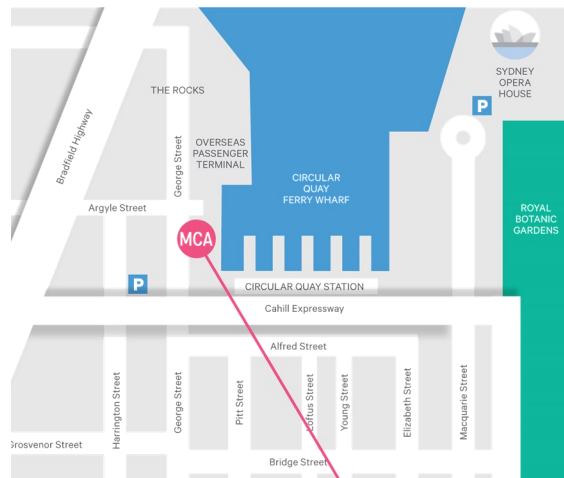
